Romania Pavilion, the first three months evaluation

June 28 – Three months after the opening of the World Exposition 2005 Aichi, Japan, Romania Pavilion represents a tremendous success. Situated in Global Common 4, we received around 750.000 visitors. The traditional restaurant situated at the basement of the Pavilion – receiving around 300 customers per day - as well as the diverse cultural daily program attracted a lot of Japanese visitors.

One of the most important events of our participation at EXPO was Romania's National Day at the World Exposition celebrated on June 1st. On that occasion, the President of Romania, Mr. Traian Basescu, accompanied with a delegation of Romanian officials visited EXPO. The program included a ceremonial performance at the EXPO Dome, in the presence of 200 Romanian artists, as well as a Japanese-Romanian Business Economic Forum "Romania-The Future Destination of your Business", attended by 180 Romanian and Japanese businessmen and officials.

Romania celebrated the first three months of EXPO by a special program featuring Romanian traditions, which took place in different event spaces from the Exposition site. It started on June 18, at EXPO Plaza, with a special folkloric program, continued on June 21, in the same place, with a classical music concert, and ended on June 23, at the EXPO Dome, with the two hours concert "Romania Classical Rhythms".
