New live performances at Romania Pavilion

June 30 – Beginning with July 1<sup>st</sup>, the daily performances from Romania Pavilion will change, the new team of artists aiming to offer a new impetus to "the interference between the authenticity of tradition and its modern treatment". The Romania Pavilion at EXPO is coordinated by the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. According to the Romanian stage director Dragos Galgotiu, who set up the daily performances from Romania Pavilion, the experience of the last three months ask for the inclusion of "an important instrumental element, whose force is in a special way appreciated by the Japanese public". "The number of visitors continues to be very high and it's already known that in Romania Pavilion are taking place daily different live performances", outlined Galgotiu.

The artists that will held performances in the period July 1<sup>st</sup> – 15 of august – is made of three big teams, different from the point of view of the artistic background: the "ritual theatre" team, "the traditions show" and "the force of music". In the first category are included ten actors and dancers that will feature very old Romanian rituals. The traditions show will be offered almost daily by folk dancers and singers from the north and center of the country. The force of music will gather young Academy of Music graduated members of the National Radio Orchestra from Bucharest that will offer to the Japanese visitors an international and Romanian repertoire.
