Joe Louis is a worldwidely renown Thai theatrical puppetry since Hun Lakorn Lek or Thai Theatrical Puppetry disappeared from Thai culture for over 50 years. Only recently, in 1985, did Mr. Sakorn Yangkeawsot, otherwise known as Joe Louis,



revived and adapted the puppets and their performance for future generations to come. That theatrical puppet reflects the art of elegant movements of the puppets dancing harmoniously with each motion of the puppeteer. Each puppeteer must have the knowledge and training of *Kohn*.

Besides, Thai Theatrical Puppet Show is a Collaboration of Many Art forms; *Hadtasin* or the crafting of puppets.

Phraneedsin or the costume of the puppet.

Nadtasin or the operation of the puppet movements.

Ketatsin or the music.

Mantanasin or the stage sets and backdrops.
