Upcoming Events

Moomin Day at EXPO (August 9 & 10)

For us at the Nordic Pavilion, the main event of the coming weeks is undoubtedly the long awaited visit of the Moomin Family to EXPO 2005. On the occasion of the 60 years birthday of the Moomin characters, August 9 will be celebrated as a special **Moomin Day**. The Moomin Family will visit the EXPO site on August 9-10, and EXPO visitors will have many chances to meet with the friendly Finnish trolls. Also, pavilion guests will be able to send a Moomin postcard to friends and family, which will arrive from Finland with an original Moomin stamp (ca 5000 postcards will be distributed in the pavilion on a first-come first-serve basis).



This will be the Moomin Family's second visit to EXPO – the first visit being on the Finnish National Day on May 12. We are grateful to the Moominvalley ArtMuseum in Tampere, Finland, for making the visit possible. Tentative program for the Moomin Day(s):

Finnish Choir gives concert at the Nordic Pavilion (August 4)

The concerts will be held at 11:30-12:00, 14:00-14:20 and 15:00-15:20 at the Nordic Pavilion (outside or inside depending on weather).

Don't miss the chance to study 100 years of Danish design at the International Design Center in down-town Nagoya. The title of the exhibition - "Use it!" – is very appropriate as Danish design is known for both its elegance and usability. The exhibition features a broad range of furniture, clothing, accessories, graphic and industrial design. Two work-shops for children will also take place on August 6 & 20.

"Use it!" supplements the Nordic Pavilion at EXPO, and will tour the world after the Nagoya exhibition.

Latest News

On the occasion of the joint participation of the Nordic countries (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden) in EXPO 2005, July 2 was celebrated as **Nordic Day** at EXPO. Between June 23 and July 5, EXPO visitors had the chance to experience various Nordic cultural events at the EXPO site, one of the highlights being a Swedish-style **Midsummer** festival. The "Nordic Days" were arranged by the Nordic Pavilion and the Nordic Council of Ministers.



On the Nordic Day, July 2, two **Nordic VIP seminars** took place at EXPO. The themes of the seminars were "Nordic models of economic and family welfare" and "Nordic co-operation within Innovation and Creating New Industries". Among the speakers were two Nordic ministers and the president of the Nordic Council.

The Nordic Pavilion celebrated its last **National Day** on July 15 (Iceland), but we are already busy planning a new cultural program for the last couple of months at EXPO, featuring **Nordic design/arts** and **Nordic music**. We will tell you more about the cultural program in our next newsletter!

The Pavilion is also honored to have received two resent visits from members of the Japanese Imperial Family. **Princess Takamado** visited on July 24, and **Princess Akiko** on August 1.
