

“DAY OF CZECH MUSIC” – CZECH REPUBLIC PAVILION  
18.8.2005

An interesting musical event involving amateur musicians from the whole of Japan is taking place at the Czech Republic Pavilion at the World Exposition EXPO 2005 Aichi on 18.8.2005. Volunteer amateur musicians will be able to perform publicly at the Czech Pavilion from 11:00. Conditions for participation in the “Days of Czech Music”, as the event is called, are one’s own musical instrument on which the musician must have been playing for at least two years, and the courage to demonstrate your art in front of visitors to the pavilion. Why not come and persuade us and yourself that you are capable of playing and winning over the public in a performance lasting a maximum of five minutes!

The first 100 participants who arrive between 9:00 and 10:00 will be admitted to EXPO 2005 Aichi free of charge. All you have to do is register with the hostesses wearing the Czech flag at the Western Gate and pick up a free admission voucher! (18.8.2005 from 9:00 to 10:00 Western Gate entrance to the World Exposition EXPO 2005 Aichi).

At the top of every hour a classic Czech composition by a well known composer will be performed by the leading Czech clarinettist Ludmila Peterková, followed by performances by amateur musicians.
