World EXPO, an occasion to make Romania known in Japan!

19 of September - The World EXPO represents a valuable occasion for Romania to get a more visibility in Japan and to enhance the person-to-person relations with our Japanese counterparts. One example in that sense is the dialogue we tried to have with schools from the Aichi prefecture. The last meeting between representatives of Romania Pavilion and young students took place the 16 of September, at Makinoike school from Nagoya, where 500 children had the occasion to watch a lesson about Romania. Also, a donation of books about Romania in Japanese has been made and the folkloric group "Dubasii din Vadul Izei" held a short performance of traditions from the north of the country. It's the third time when such an activity is held by Romania Pavilion, after the visit to Itigi School from Toyota city and a school from the Seto area.

Romania's participation at the World Exposition is coordinated by the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Since the opening of the World EXPO, the Romania Pavilion has been visited by more than 1.500.000 visitors.
