### **Number of Official Participants Hits 100:**

The Meeting of Commissioners General of Section to Be Held in Autumn

The 2005 World Exposition will be held for 185 days from March 25 to September 25, 2005, in Aichi Prefecture, central Japan. The theme of the first World Exposition of the twenty-first century, is "Nature's Wisdom." Countries from the four corners of the world, international organizations, global citizens, and nonprofit organizations will join together to work toward the sustainable coexistence of nature and humankind. Through a wide variety of exchange, people from around the world will seek solutions to the common problems faced by humankind in the twenty-first century and will draw up and propose models for the global community.

The Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs notified the Japan Association for the 2005 World Exposition on May 28 that it had received an official announcement of participation in EXPO 2005 from the Republic of Croatia. This took the number of official participants to 100 (93 countries and 7 international organizations). Of the countries, 23 are from Asia, 17 from Europe, 28 from Africa, 14 from North and South America, 8 from the Russian Federation and Newly Independent States, and 3 from Oceania.
