Allocation of Exhibition Space for Official Participants in the 2005 World Exposition, Aichi, Japan, and the Schedule for National Days and Special Days

- 1. Allocation of Exhibition Space to the Official Participants
- (1) Each of the six Global Commons represents a geographic area that is easy for visitors to understand. By visiting the six Global Commons, visitors can experience a virtual trip around the world.
- (2) The 161 modules are divided among the more than 120 countries and international organizations that have announced their participation. In order to make efficient use of the space and have appealing exhibits, 63 countries are participating in 7 joint pavilions that take into account geographic and cultural relationships. The allocation of the Global Commons is as follows on page 2. (Details of allocation as well as the layout of each Common are shown on the attached sheets.)
- (3) New announcements of participation have been made by Eritrea, Bangladesh, and the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development. At the same time, announcements of participation have been withdrawn by the United Arab Emirates, Monaco, Latvia, Mozambique, and Colombia. Consequently, as of June 24, 2004, the number of official participants stands at 122 countries and 6 international organizations (including the United Nations and its 32 agencies).
