Survey Outline

Survey method: Special gates for foreigners were set up at each gate, and foreigners who exited from these gates were questioned by category (traveler or resident) and region of residence.

Survey times: North Gate, 12:00 22:00; West Gate, 13:00 22:00; East Gate, 12:00 22:00; Seto Gate, 12:00 18:00

Future schedule: Twice in August, once in September (for a total of six)

According to the results of the first three surveys, the average ratio of foreign visitors to total visitors was 5.0% (total no. of visitors: 330,058; no. of foreign visitors: 16,558).

Analysis of Survey Results

In the two surveys of foreign visitors conducted in July, the ratio of foreign visitors to total visitors increased compared with the figure for surveys in June (4.4%) and reached above 5%. Since there are no statistics for the total number of foreign travelers to Japan in July, the following are only estimates. However, an analysis of the survey results with reference to recent statistics and estimates by the Japan National Travel Organization shows the following:

As a result of the Visit Japan campaign, the popularity of trips to Japan is firm and the number of foreigners visiting Japan is increasing. According to estimates by the JNTO, the number of foreign visitors to Japan in the first half of this year (January – June) reached 3.258 million persons, up 8.7% over the same period in the previous year and the highest for the first half of a year since 1964. This suggests that the efforts by EXPO 2005 to attract foreign visitors are going well.

Also, the number of foreigners entering Japan through the Central Japan International Airport from its opening on February 17 to the end of June was 213,300 persons, up 54.8% over the figure for Nagoya Airport for the same period in the previous year (according to preliminary figures by the Central Japan International Airport Branch of the Nagoya Regional Immigration Bureau). Furthermore, according to JNTO materials, the number of foreigners entering Japan through the Central Japan International Airport was up over the same month of the previous year by 28.3% in February, 42.0% in March, 44.2% in April, and also in May and June, showing that the figures increased significantly after the opening of EXPO 2005. (Figures for May and after are not yet available.).

The number of foreign visitors is several times more than the number of foreigners who visited Aichi Prefecture in 2004.

Regarding the number of foreign visitors by country or territory, the following can be surmised:

The top four countries/territories for foreigners visiting Japan last year correspond to the top four for foreign visitors to EXPO 2005. Compared with the previous survey on June 10, both the ratio and number of foreign visitors from South Korea and Taiwan increased. In particular, the growth in the number of visitors to Japan from South Korea, which had been low in April and May, jumped by nearly 20% over the same month in the previous year in June.

Regarding China and Hong Kong, although the number of visitors to Japan is decreasing, the number of visitors to EXPO 2005 increased over the June 10 survey.
