On the Attainment of the 15 Million Visitor Target Statement by Shoichiro Toyoda, Chairman Japan Association for the 2005 World Exposition

At around 10:15 a.m. this morning, the total number of visitors to EXPO 2005 reached 15 million.

This is the target number of visitors the Association had set for the entire duration of the Expo.
