

## Born in 1928, Tokyo

In 1951 Cardinal Peter Seiichi Shirayanagi received a philosophy degree from Sophia University, and in 1954 a specialization in theology from the same institution. In the same year, he was ordained a priest at Kanda Catholic Church, Tokyo. In 1960 he earned a doctorate in canon law from the Pontifical Urban University in Rome. In 1966 Cardinal Shirayanagi was ordained Auxiliary Bishop of Tokyo, and in 1969 Coajutor Archbishop of Tokyo. In 1970 he was ordained Archbishop of Tokyo. Committed to the cause of multi-religious cooperation for peace, Cardinal Shirayanagi became the Director of the Peace Research Institute of the Japanese Committee of the World Conference of Religions for Peace (WCRP) in 1977, and in 1984 became the Executive Board member of WCRP/Japan. He became Cardinal proclaimed by John Paul II in 1994. At present he is serving as President of the Japanese Committee of WCRP.
