

**EXPO 2005 AICHI JAPAN** 



Designs for a clearly recognizable symbol mark and popular name design logo type have been established for the 2005 World Exposition, Aichi, Japan, (EXPO 2005 Aichi, Japan) to directly communicate the appeal of Nature's Wisdom, the Expo theme, and of a Grand Intercultural Symphony, the Expo concept.

This design manual presents the correct use of the popular name and mascot characters. The guidelines expressed herein should be applied accurately when creating materials featuring these logos.

Major design items for EXPO 2005 Aichi, Japan

The Symbol Mark	EXPO 2005 AICHI JAPAN	The symbol mark is the mark used to identify EXPO 2005 Aichi, Japan.
Popular Name Design Logo Type	爱女世王非十尊 EXPO 2005 AICHI JAPAN	The popular name and popular name design logo type are used to express the popular name of the Expo and can be utilized in countries and regions where Chinese characters (kanji) are used, such as China and Korea.
Mascot Characters	キャッフロー・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・・	The mascot characters are used to offer a unity of identity along with the popular name design logo type to promote and express the Expo. The Mascot Characters, in principle, are not to be used independent of other logos.

The symbol mark should be utilized in adherence to the regulations detailed below.

The mark may be displayed without a surrounding line.




Basic shape Landscape (horizontal) combination




Single color display

If the logo is to be displayed where only a single, predetermined color (for example, a corporate color) may be used, the use of such a single color is permitted.

Displaying the logo in extremely small font

Size of logo from left to right: 20 mm or less




Size of logo from top to bottom: 25 mm or less




Two-color display

In particularly small display examples, where mesh cannot be used for printing reasons, the mesh areas may be replaced with solid color.

### Specifications for dark backgrounds

Display according to the following specifications when working with dark backgrounds. In cases where the logo is being displayed so small that the white outlined letters are not clear, the lettering should be solid white.





Dark background, small display

Where bordered letters are inappropriate, use white letters.



Where mesh is inappropriate, the outline of the leaves, the seed and the shoot should be printed in white.



## Surrounding white area

In media with a complex background, an area of white should be inserted to the specifications shown below. The specifications shown are the minimum standards; a larger white area is permitted.





## < The Spirits of the Forest >

The characters have various special powers. They can make gentle breezes blow, and deliver gentle sunlight to tired people. We do not yet know the scope of their powers. What adventures will these two have among human beings? The story has only just begun.







### Single color specifications








Variation poses are as shown below. Colors are as specified for basic poses.



00 Basic pose










