Outline

During the 2005 World Exposition, Aichi, Japan, a bank office will be open on the site of the Exposition to provide banking services to official participants and other exhibitors, as well as guests to the Exhibition.

1. Bank:

Ai-Chikyu-Haku Sub-Branch, UFJ Bank

2. Open Period:

From March 16, 2005 to September 30, 2005

3. Location

3rd floor, West Entrance (on West Gate side)

4. Services:

(1) Teller's counter

Following services are provided at teller's counter:

- O Withdrawal and deposit of cash (from/to ordinary or current account)
- O Transfer and overseas remittance
- O Foreign currency exchange and commemorative coin exchange
- O Payment of taxes, public utility charges and customs duties
 - * Foreign currency exchange service is available for the following currencies:
 - O In cash (twelve currencies)
 - U.S. dollar, euro, pound (U.K), Canadian dollar, Swiss franc, Australian dollar, New Zealand dollar, Hong Kong dollar, Singapore dollar, rupiah (Indonesia), baht (Thailand), and won (Korea)
 - O In traveler's checks (T/C) (seven currencies)
 U.S. dollar, Euro, pound (U.K), Canadian dollar, Swiss franc,
 Australian dollar, and yen (Japan)

(2) ATMs and C/Ds installed in bank office

Three ATMs are installed in the bank. At ATMs, withdrawal, deposit, transfer, balance inquiry, passbook entry and some other services are available.

A UFJ Card cash dispenser (C/D) is also available to provide cashing service to holders of credit cards issued by overseas affiliated organizations. Affiliated organizations are:

- Financial institutions participating in the network of PLUS, CIRRUS, VISA Electron and Maestro
- VISA International and Master-Card International

(3) TV Teller

A TV Teller booth in the bank is open for service during and after teller's counter business hours. With the TV Teller booth, you can speak to a teller via TV to open an account, report registered address change, lost/found cash card or bankbook and certain other services.

(Note) * The following services are not provided:

- O Opening of current account
- O Opening of, deposit to or cancellation of time deposit account
- O Investment trust, life insurance and gold transactions
- O Loan transactions
- O Money change (yen to yen)
